A) Рубрика

The diet of zebras mainly consists of grass and leaves. They can also eat bark. In fact, zebras don't need much food and they can eat the grass which is not quite fresh and green. In this way zebras help other animals which also eat grass. They eat short old grass leaving tall green grass to others. Zebras grip the grass with their lips and bite it off with their front teeth.

B) Рубрика

The genetic mystery of the stripes is unique, but the black and white colour pattern actually works quite well for the zebra in its native environment. Zebras are highly social animals and they don't mind sharing their territory with other animals. During the rainy season, they migrate in large groups, passing through different areas such as savannas and grasslands.

Zebras often appear as characters in African folk tales. Many of them are legends trying to explain how zebras got their black and white stripes. Zebras are also a popular subject in art. Modern cartoons for children show zebras as kind animals. The best example is *Madagascar*. Now zebra's stripes are also a very popular style in fashionable clothes, furniture and carpets.

Kizhi Museum

Kizhi is one of the first open-air museums of wooden constructions in Russia. It started functioning in 1951; since then a large number of buildings have appeared on the island. They were here from various parts of Karelia. The museum contains many unique items. Most of them are 17th–19th artifacts. The museum also contains exhibits of the 20th century.

The museum conducts a wide range of studies in history, archeology, ecology, and nature. It is in Kizhi and Petrozavodsk and has an advanced web portal and a web camera on the island. Kizhi museum also publishes the monthly “Kizhi newspaper”. In summer, it runs week-long education at the school and university level.
